

# DYZSOCIAL PRIVACY POLICY

Effective Date: April 24, 2023

Thank you for choosing DyzSocial, a social media platform with decentralized governance. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your personal information. We are committed to protecting your privacy and will only use your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy applies to all users of DyzSocial worldwide, including those in the European Union (EU), United States (US), and all other jurisdictions. It complies with applicable privacy laws, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA), and California Online Privacy Protection Act (CalOPPA).

## 1. Information We Collect

We collect different types of personal information when you use our platform. Some information is collected automatically, while other information is provided voluntarily by you.

### Information We Collect Automatically:
